The competition involves multiple-choice questions on math and logic and is entirely in the Greek language.

General Instructions for the Kangaroo Competition

Instructions for the examination will be given in English before the competition. The competition time is at most 1.5 hours. No aids other than writing instruments and paper will be allowed. In particular, no calculators will be allowed on any part of the competition and any cell phones must be turned off.

Parents/legal guardians are unfortunately not allowed to wait at the school during the competition. Special accommodations for students need to be requested at the time of enrollment. All requests will be honored.

Level of participation is the student's school grade level. Participation at levels other than the actual school grade level is not allowed. Participation is not mandatory and does not form part of any grade.
